MES at a glance

The formation of Muslim Educational Society in 1964 was a landmark event in the history of Kerala Muslims. The Society during the last five decades brought a remarkable transformation in the educational status of the Muslim Community. It was the educational achievement spurred by MES that paved the way for economic empowerment and political participation of the community. Undisputedly, the Muslims of Kerala owe much to MES for their present position of eminence.

MES was formed at a time when the Muslim community strongly felt the need of an organization to direct it towards the path of enlightenment and empowerment in all aspects of life. The key to advancement is education. It was this realization that led a group of muslim intellectuals to form MES under the leadership of Dr. P. K. Abdul Ghafoor, a true visionary who lighted the lamp of knowledge which ultimately brought quality changes to the life of an entire community.

The vision of MES is to work for the educational, social and economic advancement of the people of India in all possible ways. It has a mission to fulfill the vision. The Society establishes and administers educational institutions and charity homes in India and abroad to fulfill the vision.

The Society which originally started with the intention of giving scholarships to the poor students, later on started its own institutions to open the wider portals of education to the under-privileged, especially Muslims and other backward people. During the past few decades, the Society has grown to an enviable position and it is at present the biggest educational and charitable movement in India. Today the Society is managing 160 institutions including Medical College, Dental College, Nursing College, Engineering Colleges, Architectural Colleges, Management Institutes, Arts & Science Colleges, CBSE & State Syllabus Schools, ITC, Orphanages, Hospitals and Old Age Homes. MES has introduced many social welfare and awareness programmes for the benefit of the backward communities. Presently our leadership is intervening proactively to monitor the proper implementation of various government schemes for minorities and its stand on social issues is non biased and non partisan.

Ever since its formation, MES has been committed to the values of secularism, communal amity, patriotism and democracy. The Society has diligently tried to foster these values in all its institutions.

It is with a rich history of achievements in educational, social, cultural and other fields that Muslim Educational Society is celebrating the year-long Golden Jubilee of its formation. The celebration started in June 2014 and will end in January 2015. The Golden Jubilee of MES is a great leap ahead. The last few months of celebration marked great and diverse events. The releasing of Golden Jubilee Logo, laying of foundation stone for MES Head Quarters in Calicut, Construction of Golden Jubilee blocks attached to MES institutions and construction of health centre in West Bengal need special mention.
